



Adults who are not social are desexed to prevent further unwanted kittens being born, and young stray kittens under 8 weeks of age are socialised and rehomed.



Trap, neuter and return is a worldwide movement to effectively and humanely reduce stray cat numbers. TNR is an alternative to the euthanasia of hundreds of stray cats in shelters who are not friendly enough to be rehomed.

By neutering (desexing) stray cats, less kittens are born as strays and stray cat populations stabilise. Removing stray cats from an area often means more cats will occupy the newly vacant area and the problem will continue.
